Assemble Thanksgiving Fixin' Bags for INN Guests

Once you've collected your Thanksgiving donation items, get a group together to assemble the bags for distribution. It's a great group community service activity for a great cause!

Please assemble the following items in a durable, reusable grocery bag with handles. Every bag must have the same items inside, based on the list below. Sizes of items (boxes and cans) may vary.

- **EITHER 1 box of Macaroni & Cheese OR 1 box of Boxed Mashed Potatoes (please choose one or the other)**
 - **1 can of cranberry sauce**
 - **1 can of fruit**
 - **1 can of soup**
 - **2 cans of vegetables**
 - **1 can of gravy**
 - **1 can of yams**
 - **1 box of stuffing**
 - **1 64 oz Apple Juice**
- **1 Frozen pie (apple, sweet potato, cherry, pecan, etc)**

Once your bags are complete, your donation can be dropped off at the Mary Brennan INN soup kitchen, located at 100 Madison Avenue in Hempstead. Drop-off times are Monday-Friday, 9am-2pm. (516) 486-6243
